Open Learner Modelling

In most adaptive teaching systems the learner model is hidden from the user. Open learner models are learner models that are in some way accessible to the user. This may be for inspection only, or the learner model access may be interactive, with differing levels of learner control over the content. Some systems also provide options for opening learner models to others (e.g. peers, instructors). This session will provide an overview of open learner model presentation/interaction formats and related issues, and will include a lab session in which participants use some currently deployed open learner models.
